

**ORDER NO. 6 OF THE JACKSON-MADISON COUNTY REGIONAL HEALTH
DEPARTMENT EFFECTIVE SEPTEMBER 11, 2020**

WHEREAS, a novel coronavirus, which causes the disease COVID-19, has spread through the world and has now been declared a global pandemic by the World Health Organization; and

WHEREAS, on March 12, 2020, Tennessee Governor Bill Lee declared a State of Emergency to deploy additional resources to combat the spread of the virus, and on March 13, 2020, and President Donald Trump declared a National Emergency over the coronavirus pandemic; and

WHEREAS, Governor Lee has issued Executive Orders No. 38, 50, and 59 which, among other things, provide instruction for the operation of businesses during the COVID-19 global pandemic; and

WHEREAS, Executive Orders No. 38, 50, and 59 further provide that, notwithstanding the directives contained in said Orders, the Regional Health Department located in Madison County, Tennessee is authorized to issue additional orders or measures related to the containment or management of the spread of COVID-19, which may permit to a greater degree, or restrict to a greater degree, the opening, closure, or operation of businesses, organizations, or venues in Madison County; and

WHEREAS, medical experts and personnel in the area serviced by the Jackson-Madison County Health Department support the use of face coverings and masks to mitigate the spread of the COVID-19 virus; and

WHEREAS, the Regional Director of the Jackson-Madison County Health Department has met daily with local leaders in government, health care, business, and non-profit communities in order to form a coordinated local response to the COVID-19 pandemic, and these leaders are in support of this Order No. 6,


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Kim Tedford, Regional Director of the Jackson-Madison Regional Health Department, pursuant to the laws of the state of Tennessee and the Tennessee Governor Bill Lee's Executive Orders No. 38, 50, and 59 do hereby order as follows:

1. Effective immediately, Paragraph No. 7 of Order No. 4 of the Jackson-Madison County Regional Health Department, dated July 3, 2020, is hereby deleted and the following language is substituted instead:

This Order shall remain in effect until 11:59 p.m., Central Daylight Time, on September 26, 2020, unless otherwise modified or withdrawn by future Orders of the Jackson-Madison County Health Department or the Governor of Tennessee.




